- ❖ School of Sanskrit Studies (Sanskrit Sahitya, Vedic Studies and Sarvadarshan) : Rs. 11,400.00
- ❖ School of Humanities (Assamese, Philosophy & Political Science) : Rs. 12,000.00
- ❖ School of Humanities (Education) : Rs. 12,600.00

- ❖ Merit list of candidates is prepared on the basis of the percentage of marks secured in the **KBV-PGET**.
- ❖ Existing provision of reservation shall be applicable in all programme.
- ❖ Admission process including admission from waiting list will be completed on the same day. **No request for admission will be entertained after the said day.**
- ❖ Any complaint regarding provisional merit list may be submitted within **05<sup>th</sup> October, 2021** on or before **5:00 PM** positively by **e-mail** ([kbvsasuhelpdesk@gmail.com](mailto:kbvsasuhelpdesk@gmail.com)).
- ❖ Any Candidate, who furnishes false information/declaration at the time of online form submission or offline admission, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled at any point of time. Criminal proceedings shall be taken against such candidates for submission of false, fabricated documents/information under appropriate law.
- ❖ The candidates are advised to keep visiting the University website [www.kbvsasun.ac.in](http://www.kbvsasun.ac.in) for the latest updates.

### Instruction regarding Admission Procedure:

- ❖ Admission will be provisional and it will be made on the basis of marks secured in the KBV-PGET (Applicable for Humanities). The University will try to accommodate all the applicants in the subjects- Sanskrit Sahitya, Vedic Studies and Sarvadarshan. Their admission will be treated as valid only after clearance of UG examination.
- ❖ The admission process will be done on the university premise only.
- ❖ As per Govt. Office Memorandum No. PC/HE/Misc./42/2020/51 dated: 06<sup>th</sup> September, 2021, the candidate who wants to avail **scheme for waiver of admission fees** shall have to produce income certificate from competent Govt. authority.
- ❖ During the time of admission the applicant must submit photocopies of two set of all documents from HSLC onwards.
- ❖ The applicant must produce the following documents in original during the time of admission which is earlier uploaded in the time of online application.
  - Acknowledgement of Online application.
  - Acknowledgement of Unique Id
  - HSLC or equivalent examination admit card, Mark sheet and Certificate
  - HSSLC or equivalent examination Mark sheet and Certificate
  - Latest mark sheet of UG examination.
  - Aadhaar Card/PRC/Voter ID (applicants' or parents)/Domicile Certificate
  - Other qualification mark sheet (if any)
  - Caste certificate if other than general category.
  - Gap certificate (for applicants who passed qualifying examination in the year 2019 and 2020).
  - Extra-curricular certificates (if applying under EC quota).
  - PWD (person with disability/specially abled category) certificate as applicable.
- ❖ Authentic certificate from appropriate Govt. Authority will be required for those students claiming admission under EWS category.
- ❖ The applicant who gets admission to the university must submit an affidavit of **Anti-Ragging** declaration at his/her own cost. This facility will be available in the time of admission in the University Campus.
- ❖ Candidates who come late or does not turn up at the stipulated time will be considered absent and the respective seat will be filled up from waiting list.
