N.B.:

- 1) No entrance test will be held for admission into Post Graduate Diploma/One Year Diploma and Six Months Certificate courses.
- 2) The Migration Certificate must be furnished whenever the University asks for.
- 3) The original documents will be verified at the time of counselling for admission.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1) UG Programme:

Candidates qualifying in HSSLC/HS (10+2) of any discipline or equivalent examinations from any recognized Board.

N.B.: Candidates who have appeared/appearing in HS Final Year Examination are also eligible to apply, subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria at the time of Admission.

2) PG Programme:

i) For School of Sanskrit Studies:

- Graduate with Major/Honours in Sanskrit securing at least 40% marks from any recognized University

Or,

- Graduate with Sanskrit as a subject in pass course with a minimum of 45% marks from any recognized University

Or,

- Qualifying in Shastri (equivalent to *bachelor's degree*) examination from any recognized University will be considered

ii) For School of Humanities:

- Graduate with Major / Honours in the concerned subject securing at least 40% marks from any recognized University.

N.B.: Candidates who have appeared/appearing in UG Final Semester Examination are also eligible to apply, subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria at the time of Admission.

3) Eligibility for Ph.D. Programme:

- i) Post Graduate degree from any recognized University in the relevant subject.
- ii) Obtaining 55% of marks or equivalent grade in the concerned subject. There is relaxation of 5% marks For SC/ST/OBC (non creamy layer), Differently Abled (with percentage of disability being equal to or more than 40%) and Economically Weaker Section(EWS).
- iii) Candidates who have appeared/ appearing in PG Final Semester Examination are eligible to apply, subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria at the time of Admission.
- iv) An applicant who is in a service (permanent/ temporary or part time) must produce a no objection certificate (NOC) from the employer clearly stating that he/ she will be released on leave for the duration of the course, if selected for admission.

N.B.:

- All the Ph.D. aspiring candidates have to appear in KBVRET-2023, which is the first screening test of the central application process for admission into Ph.D. programme.
- Exemption from appearing KBVRET-2023
 - Recipient of JRF or other equivalent awards and eligible International Students are



exempted from appearing KBVRET-2023.

- An exempted applicant will have to go through the process of counselling before taking admission to the programme. Exemption from appearing KBVRET-2023 does not imply automatic selection for admission. Exemption can be availed only once. If a candidate has been exempted once but he/she does not appear in counseling, he/she will not be granted exemption in future. The final admission of exempted applicant will be limited to a maximum of 50% of intake.
- An International applicant will be exempted from appearing in KBVRET-2023. The counseling of such applicants can be carried out through other methods of available technology.

4) Eligibility for Diploma Programme:

- i) For **PG Diploma in Yogic Science & Therapy**, candidates should be Graduate of 10+2+3 pattern in any discipline.
- ii) For **PG Diploma in Gandhian Studies**, candidates should be Graduate of 10+2+3 pattern with Political Science, History, Economics, Philosophy, Sociology or allied subjects.
- iii) However Candidates appeared/appearing in the Final Semester/year examination, 2023 of Bachelor's of Arts are eligible subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria at the time of admission. They should upload the last semester/year examination passed mark sheet.
- iv) For admission into **One Year Diploma in Karmakanda**, candidates qualifying in HSLC or equivalent examinations (eg. Pravesika) from any recognized University/Board.

5) Eligibility for Certificate Courses:

- i) For admission in **Sasvar Vedapath, Jyotish Shastra and Karmakanda Prashianam**, candidates qualifying in HSLC or equivalent examinations (eg. Pravesika) from any recognized University/ Board.
- ii) For admission in **Yogic Science**, Candidates qualifying in HSLC or equivalent examinations from any recognized University / Board.

RESERVATION

- Existing provision of reservation shall be applicable as per Assam Govt. rule.
- Caste certificate must be issued by the competent authority under the Government of Assam.
- **UR-Economically Weaker Section (UR-EWS):** The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. EWS seats will be based on intake capacity of each department.
- **Person with Disability (PwD):** There is a provision of 3% reserved seats for PwD candidates as per the University rules. Visually Impaired and/ or Hearing Impaired and / or Orthopedically Handicapped (on horizontal reservation basis) candidates, have to submit a self-attested copy of Disability Certificate issued by the District Chief Medical Officer/Medical Board. The disability benefits will be given to those candidates only who have at least 40% physical impairments. The percentage of disability should be mentioned in the certificate. The physical disability may be verified by a medical

practitioner when the same will be possible.

- **Extra Curricular Activities:** For admission against the quota allotted for extra-curricular activities like Cultural, Sports, NCC, Scouts & Guides, the candidates must furnish the requisite documents.
- 1(One) Percent of Seat may be offered by the concerned Department for admission to UG/PG courses to students within intake capacity who have shown extraordinary proficiency in extracurricular activities in the last three years. Any sport/event organized by an association must be recognized by and affiliated to the national body for that sport/event.

FEE WAIVER

Fee Waiver Scheme is applicable as per Govt. of Assam Office Memorandum if any.

CANCELLATION OF SEATS

- A student failing to attend classes for fifteen days at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes shall forfeit his / her seat.

ATTENDANCE

- 75% class attendance is compulsory to appear in all end semester examinations.
